Making an impact

Since 2010, Stryker and Project C.U.R.E. have worked together to change the lives of thousands in need of surgical care. In the last three years, Stryker and Project C.U.R.E. together have:

- Fulfilled 273 requests, delivering 397 drills to partners around the globe
- Administered over 5,000 surgeries
- Completed an estimated 15 to 20 surgeries during each mission trip (with some orthopaedic trips completing upwards of 35 surgeries)

All requests for Stryker's Surgical products are reviewed through the Project C.U.R.E. application process.



Founded in 1987, Project C.U.R.E. has provided more than **\$450 million** worth of medical aid and services to resource-starved hospitals and clinics in over **130 countries**. Supplies are donated by U.S. hospitals, medical manufacturers and medical wholesale companies. Items are tested, sorted and packaged by a community of **12,000 volunteers** who give nearly **60,000 hours** of service annually.
